BERWICKSHIRE PROJECTS

FUNDING AVAILABLE: £45,000

ABUNDANT BORDERS

This bid is to part fund the creation of a Good Food Hub for Berwickshire to tackle household food insecurity, promote community food production and healthy eating. A Good Food Hub Toolkit will be developed and published. Bid covers project co-ordination, equipment and marketing.

BIRGHAM COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST

Residents have already improved the park facilities with two new picnic tables, replacement goal nets, and refurbishment of the existing benches. We wish to build on the recent increased use of the park by both children and parents with the introduction of new play park equipment.

CONNECT BERWICKSHIRE YOUTH PROJECT

This bid is to connect youth services in Duns, Eyemouth and Coldstream to bring young people together and reach out more to those in rural gaps. The youth project will offer new, integrated activities during the summer months. Bid covers transport provision via leased minibus.

DUNS & DISTRICT MEN'S SHED

This bid is to part fund a Men's Shed in Duns. The Shed will provide a skills sharing environment and tackle social isolation. Men of all ages can repair and make things to benefit the whole community while socialising with others. Bid is for insurance, machinery and tools.

DUNS AMATEUR SWIMMING CLUB

This bid is to start a local primary schools' swimming gala at Duns pool. The bid is to pay for pool hire, guards, medals and promotional materials. Aimed at P5-P7 from all schools in the learning cluster, it would mirror a real gala. This would be free for schools to enter.

EAT, SLEEP, RIDE CIC

This bid is to improve the lives of young people aged 14-16 who are disengaged or at risk of exclusion. Horses will be used to provide inspiration for change. Bid covers horse riding lessons, walks and training for employment – providing sense of purpose & increased self-esteem.

EYEMOUTH MEN'S SHED

This bid is to update facilities at the TEDDA centre in Eyemouth providing new machinery, improved lighting and security to extend activities for the benefit of the whole community. Office administration/ accounting software and furniture would also be funded.

FRIENDS OF DUNS PRIMARY SCHOOL

This bid is to extend use of the primary school outside of school hours for wider community use. Bid is for stage curtains and lighting for public performances, playground equipment and outdoor picnic tables. Support from dedicated parents and the wider community to install.

PARENTS & FRIENDS OF COLDINGHAM PRIMARY SCHOOL

This bid is to establish a community-based samba band encompassing the areas of Coldingham and Cockburnspath. The band will be made up of children, young people and adults from a whole social spectrum. Bid is for musical instruments and initial tutoring in first 12 months.

WESTRUTHER PARENT COUNCIL

Sustainable Westruther aims to create a community hub to encourage participation in sport and recreation activities suitable for all age groups within our local community to experience and enjoy without the need to travel. Our bid covers cost of activities, equipment & coaching.
