I spoke this afternoon with [REDACTED] SBC Planning Officer regarding the following two proposed Local Biodiversity sites, which (other than a small plot in the Fethan Wood site) are both entirely within the boundary of Glen Estate. We had previously received correspondence from [REDACTED] addressed to my late wife [REDACTED]

- Killburn
- Fethan Wood

While we fully support his initiative there are a number of mapping issues that need to be addressed. Rather than going into detail here I would appreciate an opportunity to speak directly with someone informed about why the boundaries have been proposed as shown and perhaps to offer some suggestions on how to correct them.

For example, on the proposed Killburn site plan, an occupied cottage and its curtilage have been included in addition to the head-pond associated with a disused hydro electric scheme. The plan also includes the works associate with Estate's main water supply.

At the Fethan Wood site, the majority of the proposed lands are part of the commercial forestry plantations of the Estate. I refer you to IACS Location Code 640/0002. Much of this area would be subject to periodic clear felling.
