Following your letter of 2nd November 2020, I would like to raise a few concerns, regarding your Proposed Plan.

My property backs onto the [REDACTED] and the [REDACTED]. I have been in my property for 34 years, when there was no football around, only the Golf Club. However, I now have the aggravation and hostility of being far too close to the football pitch and the community playing area. Not only did they block the right of way that was there, it was replaced with a dangerous path going past a decaying building, which is a public walkway!

The area of parking at the community/football pitch is not sufficient for the quantity of cars, or indeed buses, that use the Avenue and Johns Road to access the pitches. At the moment there is not a great deal going on while we are in amongst Covid 19, but as things go back to normal and any proposals for developing this section of land start to happen, I have to point out that the current situation is not adequate, for what is there at the moment. This should be considered a problem now and indeed in the future if other developments were considered.

This was once a lovely and peaceful place to live, not so now, please don't make it any worse.
