**SCOTTISH BORDERS LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN: PROPOSED PLAN
INTRODUCTION OF A SECOND ROAD BRIDGE CROSSING THE RIVER TWEED IN PEEBLES**

I would record my concern that there does not appear to be any provision in the Local Plan to safeguard a route for the future introduction of a second road bridge over the River Tweed.

A second road bridge would provide:

- Valuable security for emergency vehicles
- Greater connectivity for business users and residents on the south side of the River Tweed to the A72
- An “active public transport loop” linking a north and south circuit of Peebles across the River Tweed
- A recreational circuit for walkers, joggers, cyclists and horse riders

A suggested route is contained within the attached plan and I would be grateful if consideration could be given safeguarding land for a second road bridge over the River Tweed in Peebles.

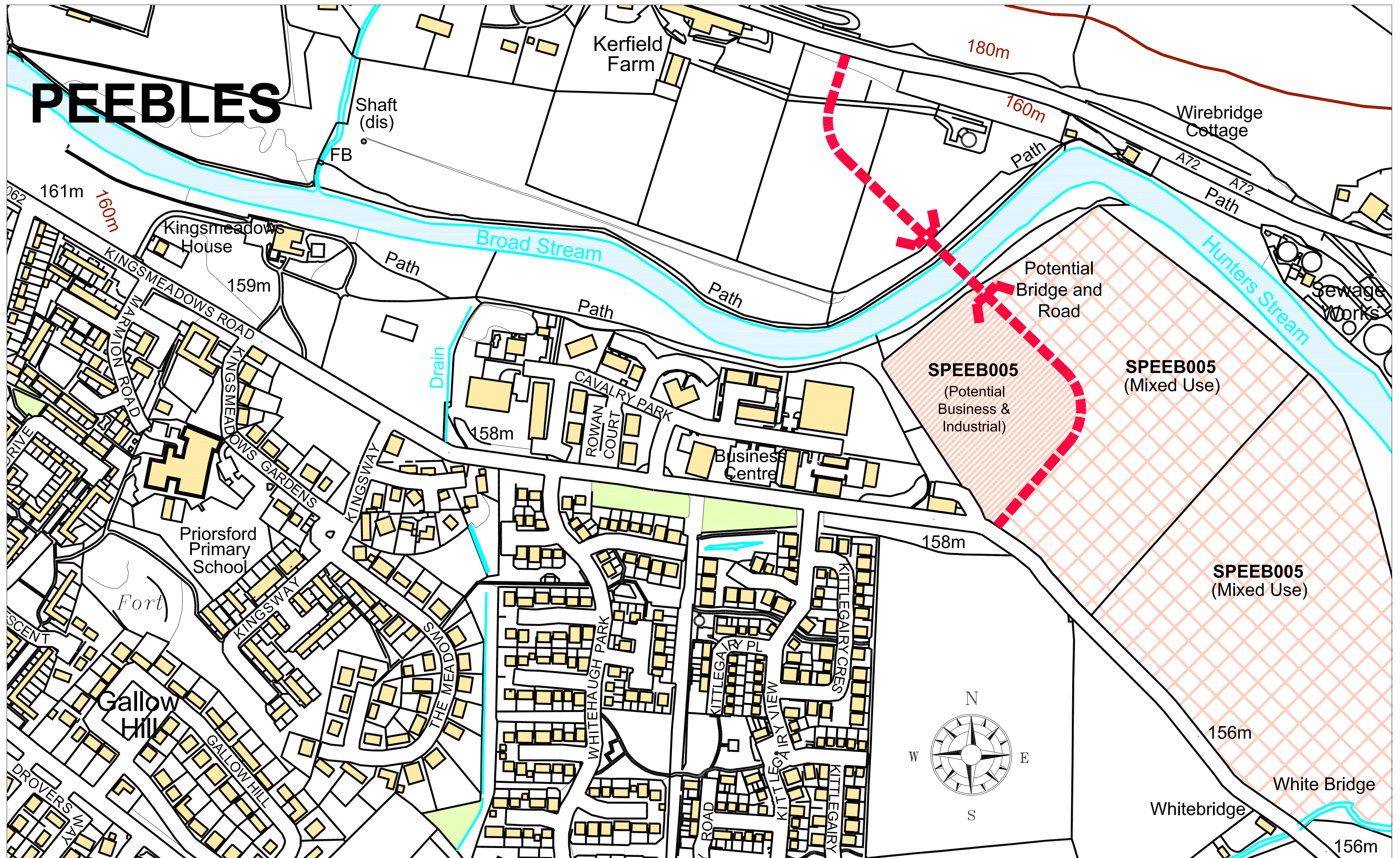
