

LATE HOURS CATERING CONDITIONS

1. The licensee shall be responsible for the collection, storage and disposal of litter and refuse emanating from his premises, all to the reasonable satisfaction of the licensing authority.
2. The licensee shall at all times carry on business in such a manner as not to cause, or not to allow to be caused any nuisance or annoyance to neighbours or to the public at large.
3. Where the licensee is operating from premises, all cooking odours must be ducted to above eaves level, or by approved alternative arrangements so that no nuisance is caused to adjoining proprietors.
4. The licensee shall comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Etc Act 1974 and all other relevant legislation.
5. The licensee shall comply with the Food Hygiene (Scotland) Regulations 1959-78 and all subsequent food hygiene legislation.
6. Where relevant, all requirements of the fire authority relating to fire precautions and safety shall be carried out and maintained and, in particular, the licensee shall ensure that there are adequate and suitable means for fighting fire and that the means of escape from the premises are kept free from obstruction at all times.
7. The licensee shall permit free access to the whole of the premises at any time to any constable or authorised officer of the licensing authority or of the fire authority, shall comply with their instructions (including an instruction to close the premises to the public for a limited period) and shall not obstruct them in the performance of their duties.
8. The licensee shall display this licence and the conditions pertaining thereto in such a location within the premises as to be easily seen and read by members of the public frequenting the premises.
9. The licensee shall effect and maintain a public liability insurance policy with a reputable insurance company all to the satisfaction of the licensing authority and shall exhibit on demand the policy and renewal receipts to the licensing authority.
10. In these conditions:-
 - (a) "fire authority" means the Lothian and Borders Fire and Rescue Service;
 - (b) the similar includes the plural and the masculine includes the feminine; and
 - (c) all references to statutes or statutory instruments shall be deemed to include references to any bye-laws, regulations or codes of practice made thereunder and to any amendments made from time to time thereto.
