- 7. New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at PO Box 13639, Council Headquarters, Newtown St. Boswells, Melrose, TD6 6BQ by 5 p.m. on 19 June 2024.
- 8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at PO Box 13639, Council Headquarters, Newtown St. Boswells, Melrose, TD6 6BQ by 5 p.m. on 26 June 2024.
- Applications for Voter Authority Certificates or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on 26 June 2024.
