**NOTICE TO EXEMPT LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS**

**GLENTRESS FOREST**

**15 AND 16 JUNE 2024**

Notice is hereby given under Section 11(9) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") that on 3 June 2024 the Scottish Borders Council made the Scottish Borders Council (Glentress Forest) (Exemption from Access Rights) No 1 Order 2024 ("the Order") under Section 11(1) of the Act.

The effect of the Order is to exempt the following land from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act:

1. Those twelve areas of land owned by Forestry and Land Scotland as outlined and cross-hatched in red on the map marked "Glentress Forest" near Peebles annexed hereto.

The purpose for which the Order is made is to accommodate the safe operation of the Tweedlove Festival mountain bike events.

The Order will be in effect from 08:00 on Saturday 15 June to 17:00 on Sunday 16 June 2024, unless revoked earlier.

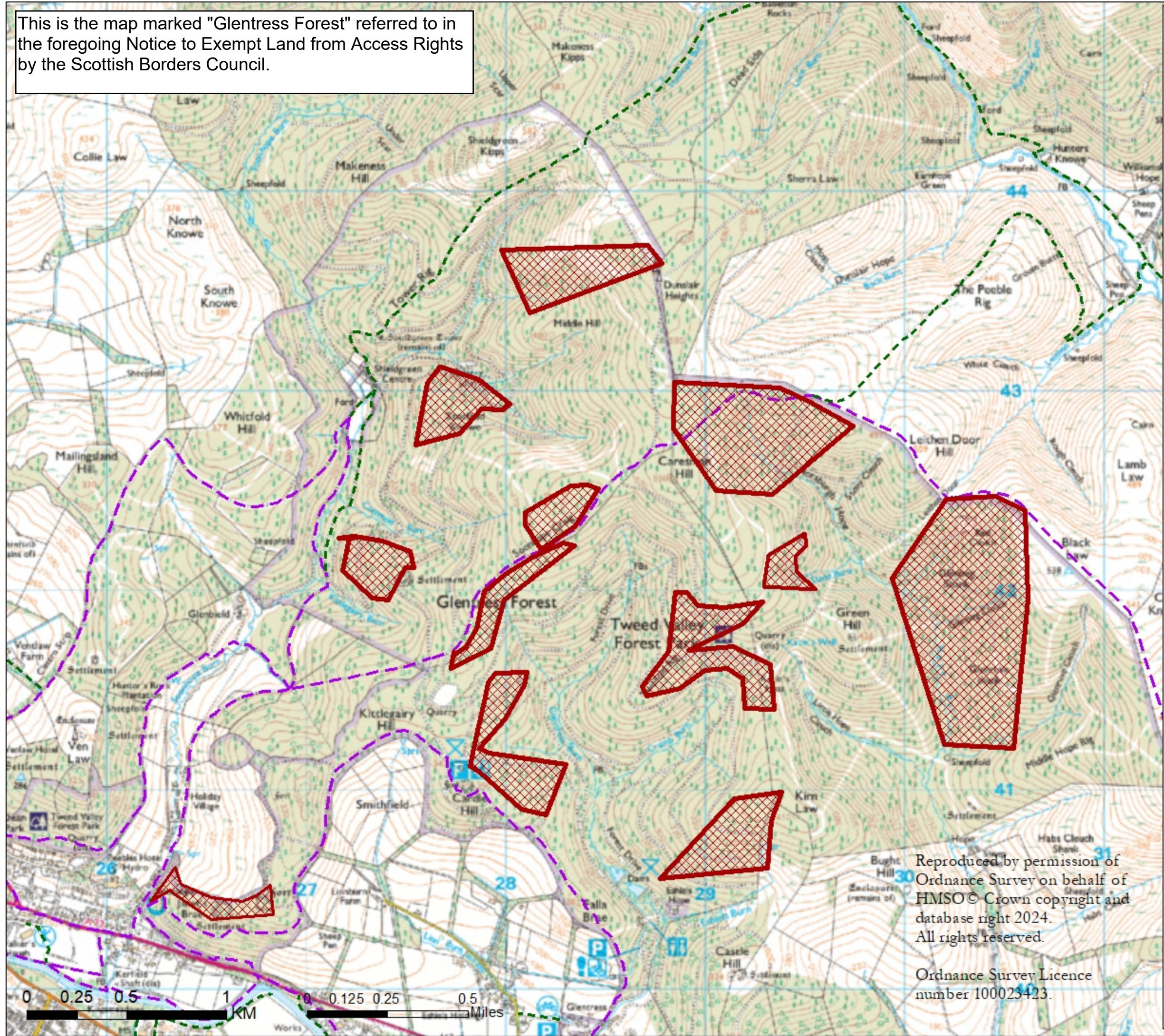
