

Coaching Scholarship

The maximum Scholarship amount awarded to any individual for an application is upto 50% of the remaining cost after being supported by Sportscotland or any other funder. Please also include travel and accommodation although we may not support it, it may add value to your application. Sportscotland offer subsidy to Level 1,2 & 3 Coaches only for sports that have signed up to the UKCC framework, further information can be found [here](#).

To be awarded coaching support the sport must be recognised by Sportscotland and be supported by the club/school you are coaching at. Applicants must be members of their individual ClubSport organisation as a club or individual. Applicants must ensure that applications are submitted well in advance, preferably at least 4 weeks prior to the course this is the same for Sportscotland

Essential Criteria

- First Aid qualification
- Safeguarding qualification upto date
- Knowledge and experience of your sport
- High level of interpersonal and communication skills
- Good at motivating and encouraging skills
- Attachment to a school/club/coaching opportunity to complete qualification
- An interest and knowledge in coaching

Desirable Criteria

- Previous coaching experience
- Awareness of good practice and child protection
- Ability to work as an individual or as part of a team
- Be confident, friendly and outgoing
- Be self-motivating and able to use own initiative

All applications must be supported by a Sports Development Officer, Head Coach or Active Schools Co-ordinator.

Payment will be made in a one-off payment, with funds only being released after confirmation of passing or qualification the course.
