Free Gutter Cleaning Scheme FORM

A new **High Street Gutter Cleaning Scheme** has launched in Hawick to preserve and protect the town's historic High Street as part of the **Hawick Conservation Area Regeneration Scheme (CARS)**. Offering free gutter cleaning for High Street properties, this project aims to prevent costly repairs by addressing blocked gutters—one of the leading causes of damp, mould, and building damage.

Funded by Historic Environment Scotland (HES) and Scottish Borders Council (SBC), and in partnership with Hawick Development Trust and the Community Council, the scheme follows a visual survey by conservation architects. Their findings underscore how regular maintenance helps keep these historic buildings functioning as designed, supporting both their structure and energy efficiency.
