2. Brief description of the content and purpose of the proposed Local Place Plan

The proposed Local Place Plan covers the area of **Coldstream and District Community Council** which includes the whole town and its surroundings, extending north from the River Tweed, and within the Scottish Borders Council area.

The Coldstream Place Plan has been developed by the Community, through the Town Team and supported by Scottish Borders Council and the Paul Hogarth Company. It sets out a vision and priorities for change over the next ten years.

The Plan sets out an ambition to address the needs and challenges faced by the community and is centred around six key priorities and ten projects, the realisation of which will benefit the community, including businesses residents and visitors.

The intention is to make Coldstream a better place for all and to attract new investment. Once prioritised and funded, each project will undergo a detailed design and approvals process, including further consultation with the public.

Guided by the Town Team, the Place Plan has been developed through a series of engagements from mid-2023 through to 2024. While rooted in the community's

aspirations, the Place Plan reflects both national and regions policy aims of creating more sustainable, liveable, and productive places.

The projects included in the Place Plan result from engagement with stakeholders and the community. Importantly, it is the town's plan, written for the community through a highly collaborative process.
