NOTICE TO EXEMPT LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS

BEWSHAUGH FOREST

11th and 12th April 2025

Notice is hereby given under Section 11(9) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 (“the Act”) that on 11th and 12th April 2025 the Scottish Borders Council made the Scottish Borders Council (Bewshaugh Forest) (Exemption from Access Rights) Order 2025 (“the Order”) under Section 11(1) of the Act.

The effect of the Order is to exempt the following land from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act:

1. That area of land owned by Forestry and Land Scotland as outlined and hatched in brown on the map marked “Bewshaugh Forest” near Larriston Fell North and east of Newcastleton, annexed hereto.

The purpose for which the Order is made is to accommodate the safe operation of the Roger Albert Clark Motor Rally.

The Order will be in effect from 08:30 to 12:00hrs on Friday 11 April 2025 and 06:00 to 20:00hrs on Saturday 12 April 2025, unless revoked earlier.
