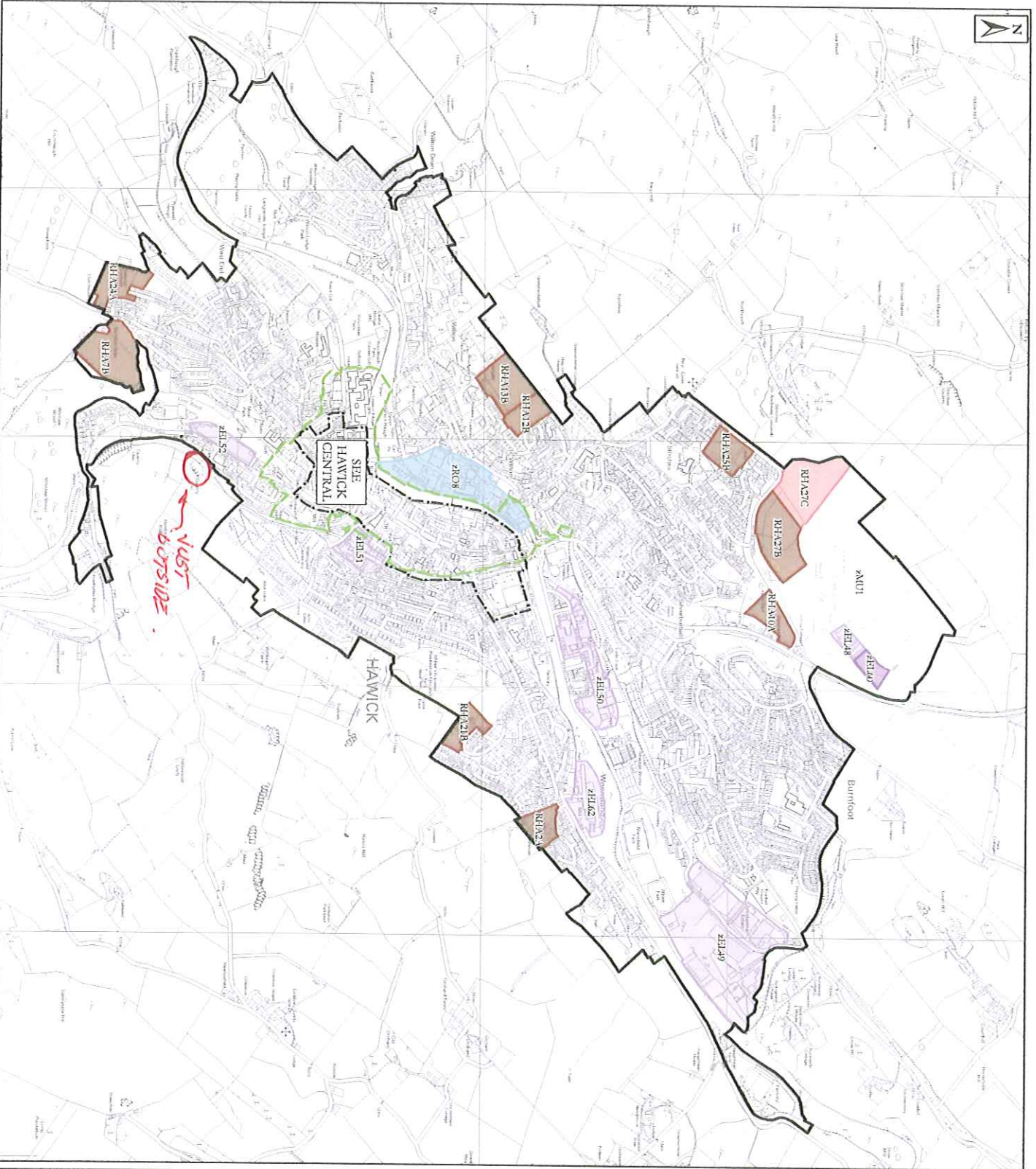
Would you please consider including the Quarry Site at Stonefield into your plans.
