
To use our new eMagazine service you must create an account.

Tap Create New Account




Enter your library card number and tap **Next**

Reading an eMagazine

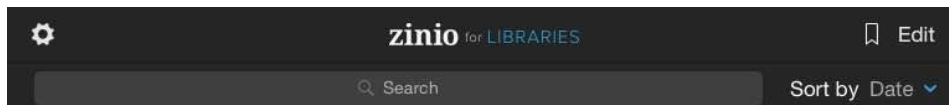
When you have checked out all of your chosen magazines from the website you can read them through the Zinio app.

Open the app and tap the **Download** icon  to download the titles you want to read.

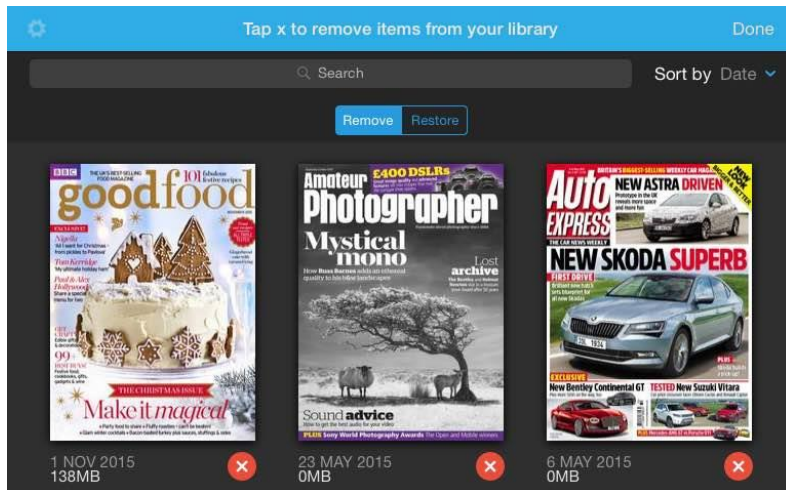
You must have a Wi-Fi connection to download the items but once downloaded you can open and read them anywhere.

Delete an eMagazine

In the Zinio app, tap on the Edit icon



Select **Remove** then tap the X on the magazine that you want to delete.



Restore an eMagazine

In the Zinio app, tap on the Edit icon



Select **Restore** then tap the + on the magazine that you want to restore.
