I confirm that the request is made in accordance with the legislation and all required information has been provided. The validation date for this asset transfer request is 20 June 2017.

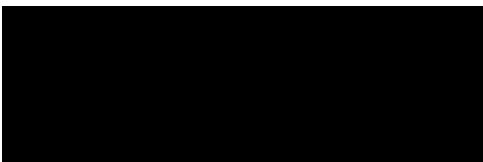
