

Electoral Statistics Update in Scottish Borders, March 2020

A Scottish Borders Insight into the data release by National Records of Scotland, produced by the Corporate Performance and Information R&I Team

Background

The electoral register is a list of all people who are registered to vote in elections and referendums. The creation and maintenance of the electoral register is the responsibility of the local Electoral Registration Office (ERO).

EROs do this on a “rolling” basis which allows the electoral register to be continuously updated. The ERO also conducts an annual data canvass in the Autumn, plus an additional canvas prior to any upcoming elections.

In Scotland, the electoral register for Scottish Parliament and Local Government elections includes 16 and 17 year olds. An Attainer is someone who has reached the age of 16 during the currency of the register. The “total electorate” figures include attainers.

In Scottish Borders, the 9 Electoral Wards conform to Scottish Borders Area Partnership (locality) boundaries but not to Data Zones. UK Parliamentary boundaries do not conform to Scottish Borders Council area.

There are three reasons why the electorate changes in size:

- Population change
- Interest in politics and voting
- Changes in the rules about who can vote
